1 (1) ADOPTS ENVIRONMENTAL NOISE STANDARDS, SOUND LEVEL 2 LIMITS, AND NOISE CONTROLS AS NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC 3 HEALTH, THE GENERAL WELFARE, AND PROPERTY;

4 (2) AUTHORIZES THE CALVERT COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE TO 5 ENFORCE THE ORDINANCE; AND

- 6 (3) PROVIDES THAT A VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE IS A CIVIL 7 OFFENSE SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 October 1, 2010.
