## 1 AN ACT concerning

### Queen Anne's County - Annual Financial Report - Filing Date

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the date by which Queen Anne's County may file its
- 4 annual financial report for the fiscal year with the Department of Legislative
- 5 Services; and generally relating to the annual financial report of Queen Anne's

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 14 Article 19 – Comptroller

- 16 (a) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, each
- county, municipal corporation, and taxing district in the State shall by the first day of
- 18 November after the close of the fiscal year file with the Department of Legislative
- 19 Services its financial report covering the full period of that fiscal year.

5 6 7 8	(ii) Unless subparagraph (i) of this paragraph applies, Howard County may by the first day of December after the close of the fiscal year file with the Department of Legislative Services its financial report covering the full period of that fiscal year.
9 10 11	(iii) Frederick County may by the first day of January after the close of the fiscal year file with the Department of Legislative Services its financial report covering the full period of that fiscal year.
12 13 14 15	(iv) QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY MAY BY THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY AFTER THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES ITS FINANCIAL REPORT COVERING THE FULL PERIOD OF THAT FISCAL YEAR.
16 17 18	(V) Wicomico County may by the first day of January after the close of the fiscal year file with the Department of Legislative Services its financial report covering the full period of that fiscal year.
19	(b) The reports required by subsection (a) of this section shall be:
20 21	(1) Properly filled in on the form or forms established by the Department as provided in this subtitle; and
22 23	(2) Verified by the chief executive officer of each county, municipal corporation, and taxing district.
