Public Schools – Law Enforcement Officers – Cultural Competency Training Program

- FOR the purpose of requiring the State Department of Education, in consultation with 4 5 the Maryland Police Training Commission, to develop and implement a cultural 6 competency training program for certain law enforcement officers; providing for 7 the contents of the cultural competency training program; requiring certain law 8 enforcement officers employed by a county board of education to complete the 9 cultural competency training program before beginning a certain assignment; and generally relating to a cultural competency training program for law 10 enforcement officers in public schools. 11

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 (A) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MARYLAND 22 POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION, SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A
- 23 CULTURAL COMPETENCY TRAINING PROGRAM FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 24 OFFICERS EMPLOYED BY COUNTY BOARDS FOR ASSIGNMENT IN PUBLIC
- 25 SCHOOLS.

- 1 **(1)** THE CULTURAL COMPETENCY TRAINING PROGRAM SHALL 2 TEACH BEHAVIORS, ATTITUDES, AND POLICIES THAT **ENABLE** LAW 3 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO UNDERSTAND, COMMUNICATE WITH, AND EFFECTIVELY INTERACT WITH THE INDIVIDUALS, ORGANIZATIONS, AND 4 5 INSTITUTIONS IN THE COMMUNITY IN WHICH THE PUBLIC SCHOOL TO WHICH A 6 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS ASSIGNED IS LOCATED.
- 7 (2) THE CULTURAL COMPETENCY TRAINING PROGRAM SHALL 8 INCLUDE:
- 9 (I) PERSONAL EXPOSURE TO THE INDIVIDUALS, 10 ORGANIZATIONS, AND INSTITUTIONS WITHIN THE ASSIGNED COMMUNITY; AND
- 11 (II) KNOWLEDGE OF GOVERNMENT AND COMMUNITY 12 SERVICES AVAILABLE TO HELP PREVENT JUVENILE ARRESTS.
- 13 (C) A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHO IS EMPLOYED BY A COUNTY
 14 BOARD AND IS ASSIGNED TO PATROL A SCHOOL BUILDING OR SCHOOL GROUNDS
 15 SHALL COMPLETE THE CULTURAL COMPETENCY TRAINING PROGRAM
 16 ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION BEFORE THE LAW
 17 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER BEGINS AN ASSIGNMENT IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
