- 21 (C) A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHO IS EMPLOYED BY A COUNTY
  22 BOARD AND IS ASSIGNED TO PATROL A SCHOOL BUILDING OR SCHOOL GROUNDS
  23 SHALL IS ENCOURAGED TO COMPLETE THE CULTURAL COMPETENCY MODEL
