18 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IDENTIFY ALL STATE FUNDS THAT ARE USED 19 FOR THE TRAINING OF THE CHILD WELFARE WORKFORCE, IN THE PUBLIC AND 20 PRIVATE SECTOR, IN ORDER TO RECEIVE THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF FEDERAL 21 MATCHING FUNDS AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT UNDER TITLE IV-E OF 22 THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADOPTION 23 ASSISTANCE AND CHILD WELFARE ACT OF 1980, P.L. 96–272, AS AMENDED.
