- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a person who undertakes the towing or removal of vehicles from parking lots to provide certain notice to certain police 4 5 departments; altering the time frame within which a tower is required to 6 provide certain notice to certain police departments after towing a vehicle from 7 a parking lot; altering the information that a tower is required to provide to 8 certain police departments after towing a vehicle from a parking lot; 9 establishing certain methods by which a tower may provide certain notice to certain police departments; and generally relating to notice required to be 10 provided by towers to police departments with respect to vehicles towed or 11 12 removed from parking lots.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
