- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "APHRODISIAC DRUG PRODUCT" MEANS A DRUG,
- 18 MEDICINE, CHEMICAL, PREPARATION, OR FORMULA THAT BEARS LABELING
- 19 CLAIMS THAT IT WILL AROUSE OR INCREASE SEXUAL DESIRE OR THAT IT WILL
- 20 IMPROVE SEXUAL PERFORMANCE.
- 21 (B) EXCEPT ON A VALID PRESCRIPTION OF AN AUTHORIZED
- 22 PRESCRIBER AS DEFINED IN § 12–101 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE,
- 23 A PERSON MAY NOT MARKET, SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, OR DISTRIBUTE AN
