- FOR the purpose of requiring the Legislative Auditor to send the Chancellor of the 4 5 University System of Maryland and the University System of Maryland Board 6 of Regents Audit Committee a copy of certain discussion notes of a certain 7 examination conducted by the Office of Legislative Audits of a constituent 8 institution of the University System of Maryland; requiring the Chancellor to send the Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland a copy of 9 10 certain discussion notes at a certain time; and generally relating to audits of the 11 constituent institutions of the University System of Maryland.

24	[(vi)] (VII) Perform the duties the Board assigns; and
25	(vii) (VIII) See that the policies of the Board are carried out.
26	(2) The Chancellor serves at the pleasure of the Board.
27 28	(3) The Chancellor is entitled to the compensation established by the Board.
29	(c) The Chancellor may:

1	(1) Have the additional staff provided in the University budget; and
2	(2) (i) Create any position within the system administration office
3	and within existing funds available to the system administration office, to the extent
4	the cost of the position, including the cost of any fringe benefits, is funded from
5	existing funds.
6	(ii) This paragraph may not be construed to require any
7	additional State General Fund support.
8	(iii) The total number of positions authorized under this
9	paragraph shall be limited as specified annually in the State budget bill.
10	(d) (1) Each employee of the Board shall join the Teachers' Pension
11	System of the State of Maryland or the Employees' Pension System of the State of
12	Maryland.
13	(2) As an alternative, any employee in a position determined by the
14	Board to be a professional position may join the optional retirement program under
15	Title 30 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.
