

Chapter 226

(Senate Bill 120)

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore City – Alcoholic Beverages – Beer, Wine, and Liquor Tasting License

FOR the purpose of authorizing a Class BWLT beer, wine, and liquor tasting license to be issued by the Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City in a certain precinct of the 41st Legislative District of Baltimore City; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Baltimore City.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

8–403.2.

(a) This section applies only in:

(1) Ward 27, [precinct 42] **PRECINCTS 42 AND 44** of the 41st Legislative District of Baltimore City;

(2) Ward 27, precinct 41 of the 43rd Legislative District of Baltimore City; and

(3) Ward 11, precinct 5 of the 44th Legislative District of Baltimore City.

(b) The Board of Liquor License Commissioners for Baltimore City may issue a Class BWLT beer, wine, and liquor (on-premises) tasting license to a holder of a Class A beer, wine and liquor license.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2010.
