

Chapter 676

(House Bill 452)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County – Office of the County Attorney

FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Commissioners of Washington County to employ one or more County Attorneys; requiring the salaries for a County Attorney to be set in the annual county budget; authorizing the County Commissioners to employ attorneys; authorizing the Office of the County Attorney to perform certain duties; authorizing the Office of the County Attorney, under certain circumstances, to hire temporarily special counsel to perform certain duties; repealing language made obsolete by this Act; and generally relating to legal services for the County Commissioners of Washington County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 22 – Washington County

1–113.

(A) (1) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY EMPLOY ONE OR MORE COUNTY ATTORNEYS TO ASSIST IN THE TRANSACTION OF PUBLIC BUSINESS.

(2) THE SALARY FOR A COUNTY ATTORNEY SHALL BE PROVIDED FOR IN THE BUDGET.

(B) A COUNTY ATTORNEY MAY BE EMPLOYED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO:

(1) ADVISE AND COUNSEL THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, COUNTY OFFICIALS, AND COUNTY STAFF IN CONDUCTING THE BUSINESS OF THE COUNTY;

(2) RENDER ANY LEGAL OPINIONS NECESSARY TO CONDUCT THE BUSINESS OF THE COUNTY;

(3) INSTITUTE, PROSECUTE, AND DEFEND LAWSUITS TO WHICH THE COUNTY MAY BE A PARTY; OR

(4) PERFORM ANY OTHER DUTIES AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

(C) THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY ATTORNEY MAY EMPLOY TEMPORARILY SPECIAL LEGAL COUNSEL TO WORK ON PROBLEMS OF AN EXTRAORDINARY NATURE WHEN THE WORK TO BE DONE IS OF SUCH CHARACTER OR MAGNITUDE AS TO REQUIRE SERVICES IN ADDITION TO THOSE REGULARLY PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY ATTORNEY.

(a) The County Clerk shall receive an annual salary as provided in the budget.

(b) The County Commissioners may employ[:

(1) An] AN assistant to the County Clerk at an annual salary as provided in the budget[: and

(2) Attorneys for the County Commissioners at annual salaries as provided in the budget].

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
