#### FISCAL AND POLICY NOTE

House Bill 270 Economic Matters (Delegate Rice, et al.)

#### Alcoholic Beverages - Licensed Restaurants - Extended Hours for Food Service

This bill allows a restaurant that holds a Class B (beer; beer and wine; or beer, wine, and liquor) or a Class H (beer or beer and wine) license to remain open until 2 a.m. for the service of food only.

### **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** Potential minimal increase in local government expenditures for additional enforcement activities resulting from extended hours in certain establishments.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

#### Analysis

**Current Law:** Although there are exceptions for some jurisdictions, the following hours are generally prescribed in statute for Class B and Class H licenses:

Class B (beer)	6 a.m. to midnight
Class H (beer)	9 a.m. to midnight
Class B (beer and wine)	6 a.m. to midnight
Class H (beer and wine)	9 a.m. to midnight
Class B (beer, wine, and liquor)	6 a.m. to 2 a.m. on the following day
