Engaged Community Offshoots, Inc. (ECO) is a new organization with an established track record in urban farming in Prince George's County. Now independent of the University of Maryland that helped to incubate us, ECO seeks to reverse the effects of systemic poverty, racism, oppression and neglect that disempowers our communities by establishing and promoting green social ventures that meet basic community needs. Our mission is to involve people from all walks of life in healthy and sustainable living activities and jobs. ECO energizes, exemplifies and educates to create the conditions for urban agriculture to become a permanent feature of our Chesapeake landscape. ECO is supported by Kaiser Permanente, the Prince George's County Executive's Office and Prince George's County Councilman Eric Olson, amongst others.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

These funds will enable us to purchase close to an acre of land to establish a farm in the town of Edmonston, remove the existing condemned structure on the site, and build a working demonstration farm. Our project-- La Vida Sana~ the Healthy Life --is an integrated approach to community revitalization designed to address the needs of food insecure and health-challenged residents. Healthy food will be grown and marketed directly to residents at farmers markets, sold to local food co-ops, restaurants, and to the Prince George's County Public School System to be served in a demonstration salad bar. Wholesome, safe foods can be expensive and hard to find, making food security and preventable ailments from poor diets, such as heart disease and diabetes, a grave concern for local communities. La Vida Sana redefines agriculture as a viable asset to communities, making it possible to grow food on small urban plots. ECO intends to support a number of interrelated and synergistic activities, all of which will contribute to ECO's income stream and which will be phased in over the next five years. The interconnected revenue streams of La Vida Sana will:

- Establish ECO-farm that grows and markets produce to low-income residents in a variety of local venues, including farmers markets, local food co-ops, restaurants, and the Prince George's County Public School System;
- Establish a Commercial Co-Kitchen that offers entrepreneurs access to modern commercial kitchen equipment in a shared space to prepare and process food for marketing and to provide community cooking/tasting lessons;
- Create, produce, and distribute healthy value-added packaged foods;
- Support the growing interest in community garden and entrepreneurial farm projects through instruction and technical assistance for nearby communities, municipalities and organizations to grow and distribute locally grown food;

• Provide education to local residents and youth on how to grow, cook, and eat healthy produce and live a healthy and sustainable life.
