10. Description and Purpose of Grantee Organization (Limit Length to Visible area)								
Since 1963, Melwood has enabled people with disabilities to lead fulfilling lives through employment, community participation, and recreation. Melwood's Kamp A-Kom-Plish is part of the Melwood Recreation Center, located in Nanjemoy, Maryland. Kamp A-Kom-Plish is an inclusive summer camp program, serving over 400 kids with and without disabilities each summer in both day and overnight camps. Access Adventures is a travel program for adults with disabilities. Each year Access Adventures coordinates 18 trips, based both at the Recreation Center and throughout the country for over 250 people. The Equestrian Program offers therapeutic and general horsemanship lessons to youth and adults in the Southern Maryland area. All the								

and general horsemanship lessons to youth and adults in the Southern Maryland area. All the programs at the Melwood Recreation Center allow each individual to try new activities and soar to personal success.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The "Kamp A-Kom-Plish Facility Revitalization Project" would update the roofs of four cabins and three additional program/auxiliary buildings. These cabins and buildings range from 20 to 30 years old and the roofs need to be replaced in order to continue to utilize those spaces. The project also includes program facility upgrades including recoating of the accessible pool to meet health department regulations and the redesign of the ropes course to make the area fully accessible to all participants regardless of ability.
