The Fort Washington Area Recreation Council, Inc. (Council) is a 3(c)1, all volunteer, non-profit organization governed by an annually elected Board of Directors. Our main purpose is to sponsor educational and sports activities through the Fort Washington Boys & Girls Club (BGC) for persons living in the Fort Washington and Accokeek, Maryland areas.  One of our main goals is to mold the youth by emphasizing the importance of volunteering and giving back to the community. The Council sponsors activities year round. All those who participate or have children who participate in these activities are members of the Council. We encourage all members to get involved and be a part of their child's future and to better our community.							

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

As part of the Council's ongoing efforts to get our youth back in the swing of daily exercising and learning and to help curb youth diseases relating to weight increase and obesity, we have been extremely successful in increasing the numbers of participants in our educational and sports programs. In order to continue to provide the services we do to our youth, we are in need of various types of equipment for each of the five sports we focus on which include exercise routines, as well as agility and skill assessments.

From an overall standpoint, we need basic items such as water coolers, medical kits, and protective gear for the sports program and for the educational program we need paper, pencils, workbooks, study guides, and classroom setup to help students who are struggling with academics. For each sport, specific equipment is required to maintain and to increase each level of completion.

However, given that this is a capital project bond bill, we are in need of bleachers at the Riverview Field in Fort Washington, MD for our youth, parents, and the community to sit on during sporting events. In addition, we are seeking matching funds to purchase and install a multisport scoreboard.
