## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

This project will provide for rehabilitation of several public facilities and amenities located within Allen Pond Park. Allen Pond Park, an 85 acre city owned property that is centrally located within the city limits of Bowie and serves as the City's premier public park. The park is maintained and managed by the City's Department of Community Services, and provides various recreational amenities that serve both active and passive resident and non-resident populations. The park was built in the early 1970's and includes an indoor ice skating arena, outdoor skate park, seven lighted athletic fields, picnic facilities, a fully accessible playground, and a 10 acre pond for fishing and boating. Due to the age of the park and changing needs of the community, several amenities and structures within the park require replacement or upgrade in order to continue to properly serve visitors and the City. The City has prepared, with the assistance of an outside consultant, a park master plan that addresses the deficiencies within the park and identifies necessary improvement areas and outlines a phased approach to implementation of the master plan. The plan is known as the Allen Pond Park Master Plan.

28. Comments: (Limit Length to Visible area)
In further response to questions #27 and #14, the implementation of the Council accepted Allen Pond Park Master Plan will include several major capital improvements. The schedule for funding these improvements will be identified annually in the City's Capital Improvement Program and allocated over several fiscal years.
The most significant improvements are: The installation of three (3) year-round restroom facilities; the replacement of the Robert V. Setera Amphitheater; realignment of the park drive and installation of an additional 250 parking spaces; replacement of the Allen Pond bulkhead; the creation of a "pedestrian plaza" in the central core of the park; replacement of Opportunity Park (a fully accessible playground) and the installation of an additional playground; installation of an interactive water feature; and the conversion of six (6) non-covered group picnic sites to pavilion sites.
