11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

- Research, plan & reconstruct the historic Market Square of Bladensburg, circa 1750-1825. This work will be based on historical/archeological research, particularly work of UMD & MDOTt. & research conducted by UMD school of architecture & real estate development.
- Promote redevelopment of key historical sites, the "string of pearls", including the Market Master's House, Bostwick, George Washington House/ Indian Queen Tavern, Magruder House, and Free Hope Baptist Church. Additional sites include the waterfront park and 1000 foot wharf, Market Square, waterfront Spa, War of 1812 Bladensburg battle sites, Evergreen Cemetery, etc.
- Recreate the Market Square to include redevelopment of a Market with possible year-round tenants such as a bakery, coffee shop, etc. Seasonal vendors include farm and sea food markets, etc.
- Encourage competitive grant applications for the War of 1812 & Star Spangled Trail, based on a comprehensive redevelopment plan focused on sustainable development, including heritage tourism.
- Leverage relocation of WSSC sewage pumping station down river, and rebuilding of Kennilworth bridge to provide safe and attractive pedestrian access between waterfront and Town Center.

28. Comments: (Limit Length to Visible area)

This project builds on current historical and archaeology research to identify essential elements of the Market Square of Bladensburg. There are important funding and development opportunities currently accessible to the stakeholders associated with the War of 1812 and Star Spangled Trail. It is essential to link such development opportunities to a long-term, sustainable development plan for Bladensburg and the Market Square, Port Towns, and Anacostia Trails Heritage Area. A successful set of partnerships with the University of Maryland School of Architecture, Preservation, and Planning, and Dept. of Archaeology provide essential technical support and advice to development of this area.
