11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

Clean Energy Capitol Heights program is a pilot program in Capitol Heights Green Initative the that will help up to a minimum of 25-50 qualified homes to receive energy audits and install energy efficiency upgrades in loans or grant funds.

The pilot program would offer homeowners that qualify access to grants or to low-cost financing for energy efficiency home improvements, like new insulation or the installation of a high efficiency furnace, water heater, energy star appliances or solar products to name a few. To help decide which upgrades and financing options make sense, participants will receive the assistance of a qualified Energy Auditor/Advocate throughout the process.

Twenty five to Fifty homes will be selected to participate thru a process from a Green Initative Committee in the early phase of this pilot, which will began in summer of 2010. Homes in the Clean Energy Capitol Heights program must be owner-occupied and located inside the town of Capitol Heights.
