The design process will include further developing of the master plan into a schematic design, based on public input. The schematic design includes pathways and walking trails, court games, lighted athletic fields, picnic facilities, an indoor sports center or community center, playgrounds, skate park, equipping, roads, and parking. In addition to public input, the County is utilizing the Statewide Recreation Survey and the resulting "activity participation" rates to determine park facilities. This survey plus the County's current facility inventory indicates a need for the abovementioned facilities. Revisions to this list and additional facilities may result from future public meetings. Upon completion of the design phase, we will proceed with the construction of the remaining portion of Phase I, which includes 2 multi-purpose fields, playground, parking, and other park amenities.
