11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The School's project - the construction of a gymnasium and multi-purpose room - emerged from growing challenges presented by the existing facility. The school's small cafeteria serves not only as a lunchroom, but as ad-hoc gymnasium, assembly space, meeting room, after-care program center and performing arts hall. With a growing enrollment and so many activities, finding time to fit rehearsals, PE classes, athletic practices and meetings in one room has become nearly impossible.

By constructing a new Gymnasium and Multi-purpose room, the School is creating two new spaces that will not only alleviate this scheduling crunch, but will provide greater opportunity and access to all students. Additionally, the gymnasium and multi-purpose room will be available for rent by local sports organizations and community groups in need of practice space or a comfortable, accessible meeting room.
