Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed Senate Bill 926 – Carroll County – Alcoholic Beverages – Sale of Wine for Off–Premises Consumption.

This bill authorizes a holder of a Class B beer, wine and liquor license in Carroll County to sell wine under specified circumstances for off-premises consumption, and limits to six the number of bottles of wine a holder of the license may sell to an individual at one time.

House Bill 1114, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 926.
