AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1252
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after “time;” insert “establishing that a person fishing under a certain permit or license who unlawfully captures a certain amount of striped bass while committing certain fishing violations is subject to imprisonment not exceeding a certain amount of time;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 34, insert:

“(3) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY PROVIDED UNDER THIS TITLE, A PERSON FISHING UNDER A PERMIT OR LICENSE ISSUED UNDER § 4-210.2 OR § 4-745 OF THIS TITLE WHO UNLAWFULLY CAPTURES STRIPED BASS IN AN AMOUNT GREATER THAN OR EQUAL TO FIVE TIMES THE LEGAL CATCH LIMIT FOR THAT PERMIT OR LICENSE WHILE COMMITTING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING VIOLATIONS IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 2 YEARS:

- (I) USING UNLAWFUL GEAR;**
- (II) HARVESTING DURING CLOSED SEASONS;**
- (III) HARVESTING FROM A CLOSED AREA;**
- (IV) VIOLATING ESTABLISHED SIZE LIMITS; OR**
- (V) VIOLATING TAGGING AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.”**
