AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 262

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “Curriculum” in line 2 down through “Requirement” in line 3 and substitute “Examination”; strike beginning with “develop” in line 4 down through “State” in line 10 and substitute “report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date regarding a certain plan for creating a statewide financial literacy examination which certain students must take as a condition of graduation; prohibiting a certain plan from requiring a student to pass a certain examination as a condition of graduation; and generally relating to a financial literacy examination”; and strike in their entirety lines 11 through 15, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 17, after “That” insert “, on or before December 31, 2011, the State Board of Education shall report, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee and the House Committee on Ways and Means, regarding a plan for creating a statewide financial literacy examination which each student would be required to take as a condition of graduation. The plan may not require a student to pass the examination as a condition of graduation.”.

On pages 1 and 2, strike beginning with “the” in line 17 on page 1 down through “**LITERACY.**” in line 5 on page 2.
