AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 722
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 17, after “provider;” insert “requiring the regulations to allow a State-regulated payor to request certain information and, under certain circumstances, reduce an incentive amount; authorizing the Maryland Health Care Commission to audit a State-regulated payor and a health care provider and, under certain circumstances, request corrective action;”; and in line 18, strike “Maryland Health Care”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 6, in line 8, strike “MAY” and substitute “:

(I) MAY”;

and in line 13, after “ORGANIZATION” insert “**; AND**

(II) SHALL ALLOW A STATE-REGULATED PAYOR TO:

1. REQUEST INFORMATION FROM A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER TO VALIDATE THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER’S INCENTIVE CLAIM; AND

2. IF THE STATE-REGULATED PAYOR DETERMINES THAT A DUPLICATE INCENTIVE PAYMENT OR AN OVERPAYMENT HAS BEEN MADE, REDUCE THE INCENTIVE AMOUNT.

(6) THE COMMISSION MAY:

(Over)

(I) AUDIT THE STATE-REGULATED PAYOR OR THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION; AND

(II) IF IT FINDS NONCOMPLIANCE, REQUEST CORRECTIVE ACTION”.
