- (A) TO MONITOR WHETHER THE PROVISION OF FAMILY PLANNING SERVICES RESULTS IN THE REDUCTION OF UNINTENDED PREGNANCIES, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COLLECT DATA REGARDING THE NUMBER OF ABORTIONS PERFORMED ANNUALLY IN THE STATE.
 - (B) THE DATA COLLECTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION:
- (1) SHALL BE COLLECTED ON A FORM DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT;
- (2) SHALL BE SUBMITTED ANNUALLY TO THE DEPARTMENT BY EACH PHYSICIAN WHO PERFORMS AN ABORTION IN THE STATE; AND
- (3) MAY NOT INCLUDE ANY INFORMATION IDENTIFYING THE PATIENT ON WHOM AN ABORTION WAS PERFORMED.".
