AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in lines 2 and 3, strike "Application of Diminution Credits and"; strike beginning with "altering" in line 4 down through "time;" in line 7; in line 11, after "inmate;" insert "requiring the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services to submit a certain report; providing for the termination of this Act;"; and strike in its entirety line 14 and substitute "Section 7-401 and 7-403(a)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 6, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, after line 24, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before October 1, 2013, the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services shall report to the Senate Judicial Proceedings Committee and the House Judiciary Committee, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on:

- (1) the number of inmates whose sentences of imprisonment following a revocation of parole were reduced under the provisions of this Act, broken down by the type of crime that the inmate committed that led to the revocation of parole; and
- (2) the recidivism rate of individuals released as a result of this Act from a term of imprisonment following a revocation of parole.";

in line 25, strike "2." and substitute "3."; and in line 26, after the period, insert "It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and 9 months and, at the end of June 30,
