AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Glassman" and substitute ", <u>Glassman, Edwards, Astle, Garagiola, Kelley, Kittleman, Klausmeier, Middleton, and Pugh</u>"; and in line 12, after "circumstances;" insert "<u>requiring a health maintenance organization to reimburse certain ambulance service providers in accordance with certain provisions of law; prohibiting a certain allowed amount for a health care service provided by a certain ambulance service provider from being less than a certain amount; requiring the Maryland Insurance Commissioner to adopt regulations to implement this Act;".</u>

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 27, insert:

"(6) "NONPREFERRED PROVIDER" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 14-201 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(2) <u>AN INSURER'S OR NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN'S</u> <u>ALLOWED AMOUNT FOR A HEALTH CARE SERVICE COVERED UNDER A</u> <u>PREFERRED PROVIDER INSURANCE POLICY AND PROVIDED BY AN AMBULANCE</u> <u>SERVICE PROVIDER THAT IS A NONPREFERRED PROVIDER MAY NOT BE LESS</u> <u>THAN THE ALLOWED AMOUNT PAID TO AN AMBULANCE SERVICE PROVIDER WHO</u> <u>IS A PREFERRED PROVIDER FOR THE SAME HEALTH CARE SERVICE IN THE SAME</u> <u>GEOGRAPHIC REGION.</u>

(E) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.".
