AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 266

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 3 down through “Act;” in line 10; in lines 10, 13, 16, 17, and 19, in each instance, strike “petition” and substitute “motion”; strike beginning with “if” in line 11 down through “trafficking” in line 12 and substitute “under certain circumstances”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 13 down through “time;” in line 15; in line 19, strike “petitioner” and substitute “defendant”; and in line 21, strike “with” and substitute “without”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 10 on page 3 through line 6 on page 4, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in lines 20 and 24, in each instance, strike “PETITION” and substitute “MOTION”; in line 20, after “IF” insert a colon; strike beginning with the first “THE” in line 21 down through the first “OF” in line 22 and substitute “**(1) WHEN THE PERSON COMMITTED THE ACT OR ACTS OF PROSTITUTION, THE PERSON WAS ACTING UNDER DURESS CAUSED BY THREATS OF HARM TO THE PERSON OR THE PERSON’S FAMILY; AND**

**(2) THE PERSON’S CONVICTION FOR PROSTITUTION WAS THE RESULT OF ANOTHER’S VIOLATION OF THE PROHIBITION AGAINST**”;

after line 25, insert:

**(2) BE SIGNED AND CONSENTED TO BY THE STATE’S ATTORNEY;**”;

(Over)

in lines 26 and 31, strike “**(2)**” and “**(3)**”, respectively, and substitute “**(3)**” and “**(4)**”, respectively; strike in their entirety lines 27 through 30, inclusive, and substitute “**CONVICTION; AND**”; in line 32, strike “**OFFICIAL**”; and in the same line, strike “**PETITIONER**” and substitute “**DEFENDANT**”.

On pages 4 and 5, strike beginning with “**WAS**” in line 32 on page 4 down through “**ORDERS**” in line 9 on page 5 and substitute “**IS ENTITLED TO RELIEF UNDER THIS SECTION**”.

On page 5, in lines 10, 17, and 22, strike “**(D)**”, “**(E)**”, and “**(F)**”, respectively, and substitute “**(C)**”, “**(D)**”, and “**(E)**”, respectively; in lines 11, 12, 14, 15, and 17, in each instance, strike “**PETITION**” and substitute “**MOTION**”; in line 13, strike “**AND A HEARING WAS REQUESTED**”; in line 19, strike “**, AS THE COURT CONSIDERS APPROPRIATE**”; and in line 22, strike “**PETITIONER**” and substitute “**DEFENDANT**”.
