## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after "for" insert "<u>nomination and</u>"; strike beginning with "prohibiting" in line 6 down through "terms" in line 7 and substitute "<u>clarifying that a</u> <u>certain provision of law provides for the term of a member; making a certain stylistic change</u>"; and after line 9, insert:

"<u>BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,</u> <u>Article - Education</u> <u>Section 3-108(c)</u>

> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2008 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement)".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 17, insert:

#### "<u>3–108.</u>

(c) (1) Each member serves for a term of 5 years beginning July 1 after the member's appointment and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(2) The Governor shall appoint a new member to fill any vacancy on an appointed board for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(3) Unless otherwise disqualified under this section, a member of a board is eligible for reappointment. However, an individual may not serve for more than 2 consecutive terms.".
