AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 679, AS AMENDED (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Strike the Judicial Proceedings Committee Amendments (SB0679/828171/1) in their entirety.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1 of the bill, strike lines 2 and 3 in their entirety and substitute "Vehicle Laws – School Buses – Driver Responsibility Blitz Program".

On pages 1 and 2 of the bill, strike beginning with "authorizing" in line 4 on page 1 down through "vehicles" in line 9 on page 2 and substitute "<u>requiring the Motor</u> <u>Vehicle Administration to establish a driver responsibility program to educate drivers</u> <u>about provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law relating to the safe operation of a</u> <u>vehicle in the proximity of a school bus</u>; requiring the Administration to adopt <u>regulations to carry out this Act</u>; and generally relating to a Driver Responsibility <u>Blitz Program</u>".

On page 2 of the bill, strike in their entirety lines 10 through 24, inclusive, and substitute:

"<u>BY adding to</u>

<u>Article – Transportation</u> <u>Section 21-1130</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2009 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 2 through 10 of the bill, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 27 on page 2 through line 12 on page 10 and substitute:

"<u>Article – Transportation</u>

<u>21-1130.</u>

(A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ESTABLISH A DRIVER RESPONSIBILITY BLITZ PROGRAM TO EDUCATE DRIVERS ABOUT PROVISIONS OF THE MARYLAND VEHICLE LAW RELATING TO THE SAFE OPERATION OF A VEHICLE IN THE PROXIMITY OF A SCHOOL BUS.

(B) <u>THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT</u> <u>THIS SECTION.</u>".
