- Only a marriage between [a man and a woman] TWO INDIVIDUALS WHO 19 ARE NOT OTHERWISE PROHIBITED FROM MARRYING is valid in this State. 20
- 21SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That an official of a religious 22institution or body authorized to solemnize marriages may not be required to

- 2 by the First Amendment to the United States Constitution and by the Maryland

- 5 October 1, 2011.
