14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE AN ADMISSION 19 TICKET TO A THEATER, A MUSICAL PERFORMANCE, OR ANY OTHER 20 ENTERTAINMENT EVENT HELD FOR THE BENEFIT OF A FIRE, A RESCUE, OR AN 21 EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ENTITY AT A GREATER PRICE THAN THAT 22 PRINTED ON THE TICKET.

1 (B) (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A 2 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING 3 \$500.

4 (2) EACH SALE OR OFFER FOR SALE IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2011.
