## A BILL ENTITLED

2	Vehicle Laws - School Buses - Prohibition on Permitting Sitting on Floor or
3	Standing

- FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person who is responsible for pupils on a school bus 4 5 from permitting any pupil to stand while the bus is in motion; prohibiting a 6 person who is responsible for pupils on a school bus from permitting any pupil 7 to sit on the floor of the school bus; establishing that this Act does not apply 8 during a certain period of time at the beginning of a school year for public 9 schools or, under certain circumstances, in an emergency; establishing a certain 10 fine; providing that a violation of this Act is not considered a moving violation 11 for certain purposes; making certain conforming changes; and generally relating 12 to a prohibition on permitting pupils to sit on the floor or stand on a school bus.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Transportation
- 21 21-1118.
- 22 (a) The driver of a school bus:
- 23 (1) Is responsible for its operation; and



- 2 1 May not drive it into any roadway without first stopping and (2)2 determining that there is no danger from any other vehicle. 3 (b) The person responsible for any pupils on a school bus is: 4 (1) The teacher on the bus; or 5 **(2)** If a teacher is not present, the driver. 6 A person responsible for pupils on a school bus may not permit the 7 number of standing pupils to exceed one pupil for each part of the aisle that is 8 bounded on both sides by forward facing seats. 9 A person responsible for pupils on a school bus may not permit any pupil 10 to stand if the school bus is equipped only with lengthwise or a combination of lengthwise and forward facing seats.] 11 12 (C) **(1)** EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH **(2)** OF THIS SUBSECTION, A PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR PUPILS ON A SCHOOL BUS MAY NOT 13 PERMIT ANY PUPIL TO STAND WHILE THE BUS IS IN MOTION. 14 15 **(2)** THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY DURING: 16 **(I)** THE FIRST 10 SCHOOL DAYS OF A SCHOOL YEAR FOR PUBLIC SCHOOLS AS DEFINED IN § 1-201 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE; OR 17 18 AN EMERGENCY, IF PERMITTING A PUPIL TO STAND 19 WHILE A SCHOOL BUS IS IN MOTION IS NECESSARY TO TRANSPORT PUPILS TO A 20 SAFE LOCATION. 21**(3)** A PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF THIS 22SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A 23 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100. 24**(4)** A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBSECTION IS NOT CONSIDERED A 25 MOVING VIOLATION FOR PURPOSES OF § 16–402 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 26 [(e)] **(D)** A person responsible for pupils on a school bus may not permit any 27pupil to stand in front of the stanchion and guardrail.
- 28 [(f)] **(E)** A person responsible for pupils on a school bus may not permit any 29 pupil to operate the front door opening mechanism, except in an emergency.
- 30 [(g)] **(F)** A person responsible for pupils on a school bus may not require **OR** 31 **PERMIT** any pupil to sit on the floor.

**[(h)] (G)** Except for the driver and any fuel station attendant, a person may 2 not occupy a school bus while it is being supplied with fuel.

- [(i)] (H) Either the driver or an adult aide assigned to each school vehicle that is used to transport handicapped children shall be certified as having successfully completed a first aid—safety course approved by the Department of Education.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2011.
