A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners – Annual Report**
3 **Requirement – Repeal**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that the Chief Executive Officer and
5 the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners of the Baltimore City Public
6 School System issue a certain annual report; repealing certain review,
7 comment, and consideration requirements related to certain annual reports;
8 and generally relating to the annual report requirements of the Chief Executive
9 Officer and the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Education**

18 [4–313.

19 (a) By December 31 of each year and on June 30, 2002, the Chief Executive
20 Officer and the board shall issue an annual report that includes:

21 (1) A financial statement;

1 (2) A comprehensive accounting of progress in the implementation of
2 the transition plan or master plan including:

3 (i) Assessment of student performance by the categories
4 required by the Maryland School Performance Program standards; and

5 (ii) Specific assessment of the extent of implementation of each
6 item included in § 4–309 of this subtitle, and any changes necessary in previously
7 established timelines;

8 (3) Sources of income and payments of debt service on any bonds
9 issued by the board in accordance with § 4–306.2 of this subtitle;

10 (4) Anticipated sources and amounts of payments of debt service on
11 any bonds issued by the board in accordance with § 4–306.2 of this subtitle; and

12 (5) Any other information as required by State law.

13 (b) (1) The State Board of Education and State Superintendent of Schools
14 shall review each annual report and comment on the progress made towards achieving
15 both managerial and educational goals.

16 (2) The General Assembly shall consider the reports and the
17 comments or recommendations of the State Board and Superintendent before
18 approving the State budget each year.]

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 2011.
