A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Town of Sykesville Employees – Participation in the Employees’ Retirement**
3 **System – Creditable Service**

4 FOR the purpose of altering a provision of law so as to require certain employees of the
5 Town of Sykesville to receive service credit in the Employees’ Pension System of
6 the State of Maryland for at least a certain percentage of certain prior service
7 with the Town of Sykesville; and generally relating to employees of the Town of
8 Sykesville participating in the Employees’ Pension System.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
10 Article – State Personnel and Pensions
11 Section 31–111.5
12 Annotated Code of Maryland
13 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – State Personnel and Pensions**

17 31–111.5.

18 (a) An individual who is an employee of the Town of Sykesville on the
19 effective date shall receive eligibility service and creditable service in the Employees’
20 Pension System equal to **AT LEAST** 75% of the individual’s period of employment with
21 the Town of Sykesville before the effective date as certified by the Town of Sykesville
22 as of the effective date.

23 (b) If an employee or former employee of the Town of Sykesville becomes a
24 member of the Employees’ Pension System at any time after the effective date, the

1 employee may not receive service credit for employment with the Town of Sykesville
2 before the effective date.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 July 1, 2011.
