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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Retirement and Pension System – Reemployment of Retirees –**  
3 **Exemptions**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the number of years required after retirement for certain  
5 retirees of the State Retirement and Pension System to be exempt from a  
6 certain earnings offset of their retirement allowance when reemployed by  
7 certain employers; and generally relating to the reemployment of retirees in the  
8 State Retirement and Pension System.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
10 Article – State Personnel and Pensions  
11 Section 22–406(c)(4)(i) and 23–407(c)(4)(iii)  
12 Annotated Code of Maryland  
13 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – State Personnel and Pensions**

17 22–406.

18 (c) (4) Except for an individual whose allowance is subject to a reduction
