(2008 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement)
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Education

7-103.
(c) (1) The following days are public school holidays:
(i) Thanksgiving Day [and the day after];
(II) American Indian Heritage Day;
[(ii)] (III) Christmas Eve and from then through January 1;
