- 16 (1) A LIGHTER MANUFACTURED BEFORE JANUARY 1, 1980;
- 17 (2) THE TRANSPORTATION OF A NOVELTY LIGHTER THROUGH
- 18 THE STATE; OR
- 19 (3) THE STORAGE OF A NOVELTY LIGHTER IN A WAREHOUSE IN
- 20 THE STATE THAT IS NOT OPEN FOR RETAIL SALES.
- 21 (C) A PERSON MAY NOT SELL AT RETAIL, OFFER FOR SALE AT RETAIL,
- 22 OR DISTRIBUTE FOR RETAIL SALE IN THE STATE A NOVELTY LIGHTER.
- 23 (D) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
- 24 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING
- 25 **\$500**.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 27 October 1, 2011.
