Motor Vehicles – Use of Text Messaging Device While Driving

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing that a certain prohibition against a person under a 4 certain age using a wireless communication device while operating a motor $\mathbf{5}$ vehicle does not apply to the use of a wireless communication device as a text 6 messaging device; clarifying that a certain prohibition against a person using a 7 text messaging device to write or send a text message while operating a motor 8 vehicle under certain circumstances includes a prohibition against writing or 9 sending an electronic message; making a certain technical correction; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to the use of a text messaging device 10 11 while driving.

5 (3) "Text messaging device" means a hand held device used to send a 6 text message or an electronic message via a short message service, wireless telephone 7 service, or electronic communication network.

8 (b) Subject to subsection (c) of this section, a person may not use a text 9 messaging device to write or send a text message OR AN ELECTRONIC MESSAGE 10 while operating a motor vehicle in motion or in the travel portion of the roadway.

- 11 (c) This section does not apply to the use of:
- 12 (1) A global positioning system; or
- 13 (2) A text messaging device to contact a 9–1–1 system.
