## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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## Natural Resources - Oyster Poaching - Hearing

3 FOR the purpose of providing that a certain person who receives a citation for a 4 certain offense related to unlawfully taking oysters may have a certain license 5 revoked under certain circumstances; establishing certain grounds for the 6 revocation of a certain license; requiring the Department of Natural Resources 7 to hold a certain hearing under certain circumstances in accordance with the 8 Administrative Procedure Act; requiring the Department to revoke a person's 9 license to catch oysters under certain circumstances; authorizing certain aggrieved persons to obtain judicial review of a certain decision; prohibiting a 10 certain person from engaging or working in a certain fishery under certain 11 12 circumstances; and generally relating to unlawfully taking oysters and license 13 revocation.

- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 23 (A) (1) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY OR FINE PROVIDED IN 24 THIS TITLE, A PERSON WHO HOLDS A LICENSE TO CATCH OYSTERS UNDER §

- 3 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
- 4 (2) THE FOLLOWING OFFENSES, COMMITTED IN VIOLATION OF
- 5 THIS TITLE OR OF ANY REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS TITLE, ARE
- 6 GROUNDS FOR REVOCATION OF A LICENSE TO CATCH OYSTERS UNDER THIS
- 7 SECTION:
- 8 (I) TAKING OYSTERS LOCATED MORE THAN 200 FEET
- 9 WITHIN A CLOSED OR PROHIBITED AREA;
- 10 (II) TAKING OYSTERS WITH GEAR THAT IS PROHIBITED IN
- 11 THAT AREA;
- 12 (III) TAKING OYSTERS OUTSIDE OF A TIME RESTRICTION
- 13 FOR THE HARVEST OF OYSTERS BY MORE THAN 1 HOUR;
- 14 (IV) TAKING OYSTERS DURING CLOSED SEASONS; AND
- 15 (V) TAKING OYSTERS FROM A LEASED AREA BY A PERSON
- 16 OTHER THAN THE LEASEHOLDER OR THE LEASEHOLDER'S DESIGNEE.
- 17 (B) (1) WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER A PERSON WHO HOLDS A LICENSE TO
- 18 CATCH OYSTERS UNDER § 4–701 OF THIS TITLE RECEIVES A CITATION FOR AN
- 19 OFFENSE LISTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT
- 20 SHALL HOLD A HEARING ON THE MATTER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
- 21 ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT UNDER TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THE
- 22 STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- 23 (2) AFTER A HEARING IS CONDUCTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF
- 24 THIS SUBSECTION, IF THE PRESIDING OFFICER FINDS OR CONCLUDES THAT THE
- 25 PERSON KNOWINGLY HAS COMMITTED AN OFFENSE LISTED UNDER SUBSECTION
- 26 (A)(2) OF THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REVOKE THE PERSON'S
- 27 LICENSE TO CATCH OYSTERS.
- 28 (C) A PERSON WHO IS AGGRIEVED BY THE FINAL DECISION OF THE
- 29 DEPARTMENT MAY OBTAIN JUDICIAL REVIEW OF THE DECISION IN
- 30 ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE ACT UNDER TITLE 10,
- 31 SUBTITLE 2 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
- 32 (D) A PERSON WHOSE LICENSE HAS BEEN REVOKED IN ACCORDANCE
- 33 WITH THIS SECTION MAY NOT ENGAGE OR WORK IN THE FISHERY FOR WHICH
- 34 THE LICENSE WAS REVOKED WHETHER OR NOT IT REQUIRES THE USE OF
- 35 ANOTHER LICENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

2 October 1, 2011.
