## A BILL ENTITLED

## Motor Vehicles - Registration Plate Covers

FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "registration plate cover" that applies to certain prohibited acts to exclude clear covers and certain covers that do not obscure or block any of the characters of the registration plate, and to include certain covers that function to obscure or block any characters of the registration plate.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation
13-411.
(c) At all times, each registration plate shall be:
(1) Maintained free from foreign materials, including registration plate covers as defined in § $13-411.1$ of this subtitle, and in a condition to be clearly legible; and
(2) Securely fastened to the vehicle for which it is issued:
(i) In a horizontal position;
(ii) In a manner that prevents the plate from swinging; and
(iii) In a place and position to be clearly visible.

13-411.1.
(a) In this section, "registration plate cover" means any tinted, colored, painted, marked, [clear,] or illuminated object that is designed OR FUNCTIONS to:
(1) [Cover] OBSCURE OR BLOCK any of the characters of a vehicle's registration plate; or
(2) Distort a recorded image of any of the characters of a vehicle's registration plate recorded by a traffic control signal monitoring system under $\S 21-202.1$ of this article.
(b) A person may not sell or offer for sale a registration plate cover.
(c) A person may not advertise for the purpose of promoting the sale of registration plate covers.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
