citizen activities centers; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the
inspection of the records of senior citizen activities centers under the Public

7 (M) (1) "SENIOR CITIZEN ACTIVITIES CENTER" HAS THE MEANING 8 STATED IN § 10–513 OF THE HUMAN SERVICES ARTICLE.

9 (2) A CUSTODIAN SHALL DENY INSPECTION OF THE PART OF A 10 PUBLIC RECORD THAT CONTAINS THE NAME, ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER, 11 OR ELECTRONIC MAIL ADDRESS OF ANY INDIVIDUAL ENROLLED IN OR ANY 12 MEMBER OF A SENIOR CITIZEN ACTIVITIES CENTER.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect14 October 1, 2011.
