1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Information Act – Required Denials – Senior Citizen Activities**
3 **Centers**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a custodian of records under the Public Information Act
5 to deny inspection of the part of a public record that contains certain
6 information regarding an individual enrolled in or a member of certain senior
7 citizen activities centers; requiring a custodian to permit inspection of certain
8 information by a person in interest, law enforcement personnel, and emergency
9 services personnel; defining ~~a certain term~~ terms; and generally relating to the
10 inspection of the records of senior citizen activities centers under the Public
11 Information Act.

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 7 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

8 **Article – Human Services**

9 10–513.

10 (c) “Senior citizen activities center” means a community or neighborhood
 11 facility in which a broad spectrum of services are organized and provided to seniors
 12 and their spouses, including health, social, nutritional, educational, and recreational
 13 services.

14 **Article – State Government**

15 10–611.

16 (e) “Person in interest” means:

17 (1) a person or governmental unit that is the subject of a public record
 18 or a designee of the person or governmental unit;

19 (2) if the person has a legal disability, the parent or legal
 20 representative of the person; or

21 (3) as to requests for correction of certificates of death under §
 22 5–310(d)(2) of the Health – General Article, the spouse, adult child, parent, adult
 23 sibling, grandparent, or guardian of the person of the deceased at the time of the
 24 deceased’s death.

26 (M) (1) **“SENIOR CITIZEN ACTIVITIES CENTER” HAS THE MEANING**
 27 **STATED IN § 10–513 OF THE HUMAN SERVICES ARTICLE.**

28 (2) **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS**
 29 **SUBSECTION, A CUSTODIAN SHALL DENY INSPECTION OF THE PART OF A PUBLIC**
 30 **RECORD THAT CONTAINS THE NAME, ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER, OR**
 31 **ELECTRONIC MAIL ADDRESS OF ANY INDIVIDUAL ENROLLED IN OR ANY MEMBER**
 32 **OF A SENIOR CITIZEN ACTIVITIES CENTER.**

- 1 **(3) A CUSTODIAN SHALL PERMIT INSPECTION BY:**
- 2 **(I) A PERSON IN INTEREST;**
- 3 **(II) LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL; OR**
- 4 **(III) EMERGENCY SERVICES PERSONNEL, INCLUDING:**
- 5 **1. A CAREER FIREFIGHTER;**
- 6 **2. AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDER,**
7 **AS DEFINED IN § 13-516 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE;**
- 8 **3. A RESCUE SQUAD EMPLOYEE; AND**
- 9 **4. A VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER, RESCUE SQUAD**
10 **MEMBER, OR ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT UNIT MEMBER.**

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2011.
