A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Maryland Green Purchasing Committee – Recycling Study – Polystyrene Foam

FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Green Purchasing Committee to study the
cost and feasibility of recycling polystyrene foam products at State-owned
facilities, including a certain cost comparison; requiring the Committee, on or
before a certain date, to report its findings and recommendations to the Senate
Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee and the House
Health and Government Operations Committee; and generally relating to
recycling at State-owned facilities.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That:

(a) (1) The Maryland Green Purchasing Committee shall study the cost
 and feasibility of recycling polystyrene foam products at State–owned facilities.

15 (2) The study required under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall 16 include a comparison of the cost to procure recyclable alternatives to products made 17 with polystyrene foam that are currently procured by the State to the cost to continue 18 to use the polystyrene foam products and to recycle the products.

19 (b) On or before January 1, 2012, the Maryland Green Purchasing 20 Committee shall report its findings and recommendations under the study required 21 under subsection (a) of this section, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State 22 Government Article, to the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs 23 Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 July 1, 2011.
