A BILL ENTITLED

Lottery for Schools Act of 2011

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain lottery proceeds to 4 certain public school systems for certain purposes; specifying that certain 5 lottery proceeds be distributed to the General Fund of the State and used to 6 help fund a certain statewide program for public education; specifying that the 7 proceeds distributed under this Act to a public school system are intended to 8 provide additional revenue for public school systems and may not supplant 9 other revenue distributed to public school systems; making stylistic changes; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the distribution of lottery 10 proceeds to public school systems in the State and to the General Fund of the 11 12 State.

- 1 (a) The Comptroller shall distribute the State Lottery Fund to pay: 2 on a pro rata basis for the daily and nondaily State lottery games, (1) 3 the expenses of administering and operating the State lottery, as authorized under 4 this subtitle and the State budget; and then, except as provided in § 10-113.1 of the Family Law Article 5 6 and § 11-618 of the Criminal Procedure Article, the holder of each winning ticket or 7 share. 8 Promptly after the 1st day of each month, AFTER THE (b) (1) 9 DISTRIBUTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, the Comptroller shall 10 pay: 11 into the Maryland Stadium Facilities Fund the money that 12 remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of the sports lotteries conducted 13 for the benefit of the Maryland Stadium Authority, after the distribution under subsection (a) of this section]; and 14 15 into the General Fund of the State | SUBJECT TO § (ii) 9-120.2 OF THIS SUBTITLE, OF the money that remains in the State Lottery Fund 16 from the proceeds of all other lotteries after the distribution under subsection (a) of 17 18 this section LOTTERIES OTHER THAN THE SPORTS LOTTERIES CONDUCTED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE MARYLAND STADIUM AUTHORITY: 19 20 1. 25% TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS IN THE 21 STATE, ON A PRO RATA BASIS ACCORDING TO THE TOTAL LOTTERY SALES MADE 22 IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM IS LOCATED; AND 23 2. 75% TO THE GENERAL FUND. 24The money paid into the General Fund under this subsection is 25 available in the fiscal year in which the money accumulates in the State Lottery Fund. 26 The regulations of the Agency shall apportion the money in the State (c) 27 Lottery Fund. 28 9-120.2.

- 10 (II) INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS.
- 11 (C) THE PROCEEDS PAID INTO THE GENERAL FUND UNDER §
 12 9–120(B)(1)(II)2 OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE USED TO HELP PROVIDE AN
 13 ADEQUATE EDUCATION FOR THE STUDENTS ATTENDING PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN
 14 THE STATE IN PREKINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 12 THROUGH THE BRIDGE
 15 TO EXCELLENCE IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS PROGRAM, ENACTED BY CHAPTER 288
 16 OF THE ACTS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2002.
- 17 **(D)** A DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 9–120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE IS
 18 INTENDED TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REVENUE FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS
 19 AND MAY NOT SUPPLANT ANY OTHER REVENUE DISTRIBUTED TO PUBLIC
 20 SCHOOL SYSTEMS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
