## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

## Lottery for Schools Act of 2011

FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain lottery proceeds to certain public school systems for certain purposes; specifying that certain lottery proceeds be distributed to the General Fund of the State and used to help fund a certain statewide program for public education; specifying that the proceeds distributed under this Act to a public school system are intended to provide additional revenue for public school systems and may not supplant other revenue distributed to public school systems; making stylistic changes; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the distribution of lottery proceeds to public school systems in the State and to the General Fund of the State.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.
(a) The Comptroller shall distribute the State Lottery Fund to pay:
(1) on a pro rata basis for the daily and nondaily State lottery games, the expenses of administering and operating the State lottery, as authorized under this subtitle and the State budget; and
(2) then, except as provided in § 10-113.1 of the Family Law Article and § 11-618 of the Criminal Procedure Article, the holder of each winning ticket or share.
(b) (1) Promptly after the 1st day of each month, AFTER THE DISTRIBUTION UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, the Comptroller shall pay:
(i) into the Maryland Stadium Facilities Fund the money that remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of the sports lotteries conducted for the benefit of the Maryland Stadium Authority[, after the distribution under subsection (a) of this section]; and
(ii) [into the General Fund of the State] SUBJECT TO § 9-120.2 OF THIS SUBTITLE, OF the money that remains in the State Lottery Fund from the proceeds of all [other lotteries after the distribution under subsection (a) of this section] LOTTERIES OTHER THAN THE SPORTS LOTTERIES CONDUCTED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE MARYLAND STADIUM AUTHORITY:

1. 25\% TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS IN THE STATE, ON A PRO RATA BASIS ACCORDING TO THE TOTAL LOTTERY SALES MADE IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM IS LOCATED; AND

## 2. $75 \%$ TO THE GENERAL FUND.

(2) The money paid into the General Fund under this subsection is available in the fiscal year in which the money accumulates in the State Lottery Fund.
(c) The regulations of the Agency shall apportion the money in the State Lottery Fund.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM" MEANS THE COLLECTION OF PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION SCHOOLS UNDER THE CONTROL OF A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE CITY.
(B) (1) THE AMOUNT DISTRIBUTED TO EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM UNDER THE DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENT UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II)1 OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE PROPORTIONATE TO THE AMOUNT OF SALES OF LOTTERY TICKETS MADE IN THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IN WHICH THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM IS LOCATED.
(2) EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL USE THE MONEY FROM THE SALE OF STATE LOTTERY TICKETS THAT IS DISTRIBUTED UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) 1 OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR:
(I) CLASSROOM STAFF; AND
(II) INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS.
(C) The proceeds paid into the General Fund under § 9-120(B)(1)(II) 2 OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE USED TO HELP PROVIDE AN adequate education for the students attending public schools in the State in prekindergarten through grade 12 through the Bridge to Excellence in Public Schools Program, enacted by Chapter 288 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2002.
(D) A DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE IS INTENDED TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REVENUE FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS and may not supplant any other revenue distributed to public SCHOOL SYSTEMS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
