BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages Section 2-101(u)(1)Annotated Code of Maryland (2005 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement) BY adding to Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages Section 2-101(u)(9)Annotated Code of Maryland (2005 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

 - 2 (u) (1) The Office of the Comptroller may issue a winery special event 3 permit to a licensed Class 4 Maryland limited winery, provided that:
 - 4 (i) Except as provided in paragraphs (6), (7), [and] (8), AND (9)
- 6 Class 4 Maryland limited winery in any given calendar year;
- 7 (ii) The permit does not exceed 3 consecutive days; and
- 8 (iii) Except as provided in paragraphs (6), (7), [and] (8), AND (9)
