19 20 21	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY" INCLUDES INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS, MUSIC, DRAMA PROGRAMS, STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS, OR OTHER PROGRAMS SPONSORED BY A SCHOOL:

- 1 (2) FOR WHICH A STUDENT DOES NOT EARN ACADEMIC CREDIT.
- 2 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A
 3 PUBLIC SCHOOL MAY ALLOW A STUDENT WHO IS NOT ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL
 4 TO PARTICIPATE IN AN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY SPONSORED BY THE

- 11 (C) A PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL GIVE PLACEMENT PRIORITY TO A 12 STUDENT THE **PUBLIC** SCHOOL **SPONSORING ENROLLED** IN13 EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY OVER A STUDENT WHO IS NOT ENROLLED IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOL IF THERE ARE A LIMITED NUMBER OF SPACES AVAILABLE FOR 14 15 STUDENTS IN THE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
