17 18	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 22 23	(b) (1) A work zone speed control system that meets the requirements of this subsection may be used to record the images of motor vehicles traveling on a highway:
24	(i) Within a work zone;

$\frac{1}{2}$	(ii) That is an expressway or a controlled access highway as defined in $\S 21-101$ of this title; and
3 4	(iii) On which the speed limit, established using generally accepted traffic engineering practices, is 45 miles per hour or greater.
5	(2) A work zone speed control system may be used only:
6 7	(i) On a highway as specified in paragraph (1) of this subsection;
8 9	(ii) When being operated by a work zone speed control system operator; and
10 11 12	(iii) If, in accordance with the Maryland manual on uniform traffic control devices, a conspicuous road sign is placed at a reasonable distance consistent with national guidelines before the work zone alerting drivers that [a]:
13 14	1. A speed monitoring system may be in operation in the work zone; AND
15 16	2. IMAGES OF VEHICLES MAY BE RECORDED EVEN IF THERE ARE NO WORKERS PRESENT.
17 18	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
