BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 15 **Article - Education** 16 9-108.17 (a) Employees of a public charter school: Are public school employees, as defined in §§ 6–401(e) and 6–501(g) 18 (1) 19 of this article: 20 Are employees of a public school employer, as defined in §§ 216-401(f) and 6-501(h) of this article, in the county in which the public charter school is located; and 22

- (b) If a collective bargaining agreement under Title 6, Subtitle 4 or Subtitle 5 of this article is already in existence in the county where a public charter school is located, the employee organization and the public charter school may mutually agree to negotiate amendments to the existing agreement to address the needs of the particular public charter school.
- 8 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW OR CONTRACT, MUTUAL CONSENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY BOARD AND CHARTER OPERATOR SHALL GOVERN THE HIRING OF ALL QUALIFIED AND CERTIFICATED INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE WORKING IN A PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a presently existing 13 obligation or contract right may not be impaired by this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 15 July 1, 2011.
