- 1 (A) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL ENCOURAGE THE USE OF OPEN SPACE 2 ON PUBLIC SCHOOL PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLANTING AND 3 MAINTAINING GARDENS.
- 4 (B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A COUNTY BOARD SHALL AUTHORIZE THE USE OF OPEN SPACE ON PUBLIC SCHOOL PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLANTING AND MAINTAINING GARDENS THROUGHOUT THE CALENDAR YEAR BY SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITY GROUPS.
- 8 (C) EACH SCHOOL OR COMMUNITY GROUP THAT PLANTS OR MAINTAINS 9 A GARDEN ON SCHOOL PROPERTY SHALL:
- 10 (1) SUBMIT A PLAN TO THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT FOR
  11 MAINTENANCE OF THE GARDEN WHEN THE SCHOOL IS NOT OPEN DURING THE
  12 REGULAR SCHOOL CALENDAR YEAR; AND
- 13 (2) LIMIT THE APPLICATION OF PESTICIDES TO THE GARDEN
  14 THROUGH THE USE OF ORGANIC VEGETABLE GARDENING TECHNIQUES OR
  15 INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT.

## 16 (D) A COUNTY BOARD MAY:

- 17 (1) INCORPORATE THE USE OF SCHOOL GARDENS INTO THE CURRICULUM GUIDES AND COURSES OF STUDY RELATING TO NUTRITION, 19 HEALTH, AND HORTICULTURE INSTRUCTION FOR THE SCHOOLS UNDER ITS JURISDICTION; AND
- 21 (2) USE THE PRODUCE GROWN IN SCHOOL GARDENS IN SCHOOL 22 CAFETERIAS IN ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LAWS AND 23 REGULATIONS GOVERNING FOOD SAFETY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
